EQAO's 2022–2023 Ontario Secondary **School Literacy Test (OSSLT)**



The OSSLT measures whether students are meeting the minimum standard for literacy across all subjects up to the end of Grade 9.




171 177 students fully participated

*For the 2021–2022 school year, previously eligible students included Grade 11 students who were unable to write the OSSLT in Grade 10 because of the pandemic-related pause in the EQAO assessments. Compared with the 2018–2019 cohort, which is a better comparison, the 2022–2023 results represent an increase (from 50% to 63%).

Overall success rates are high, showing stability in the literacy skills acquired
