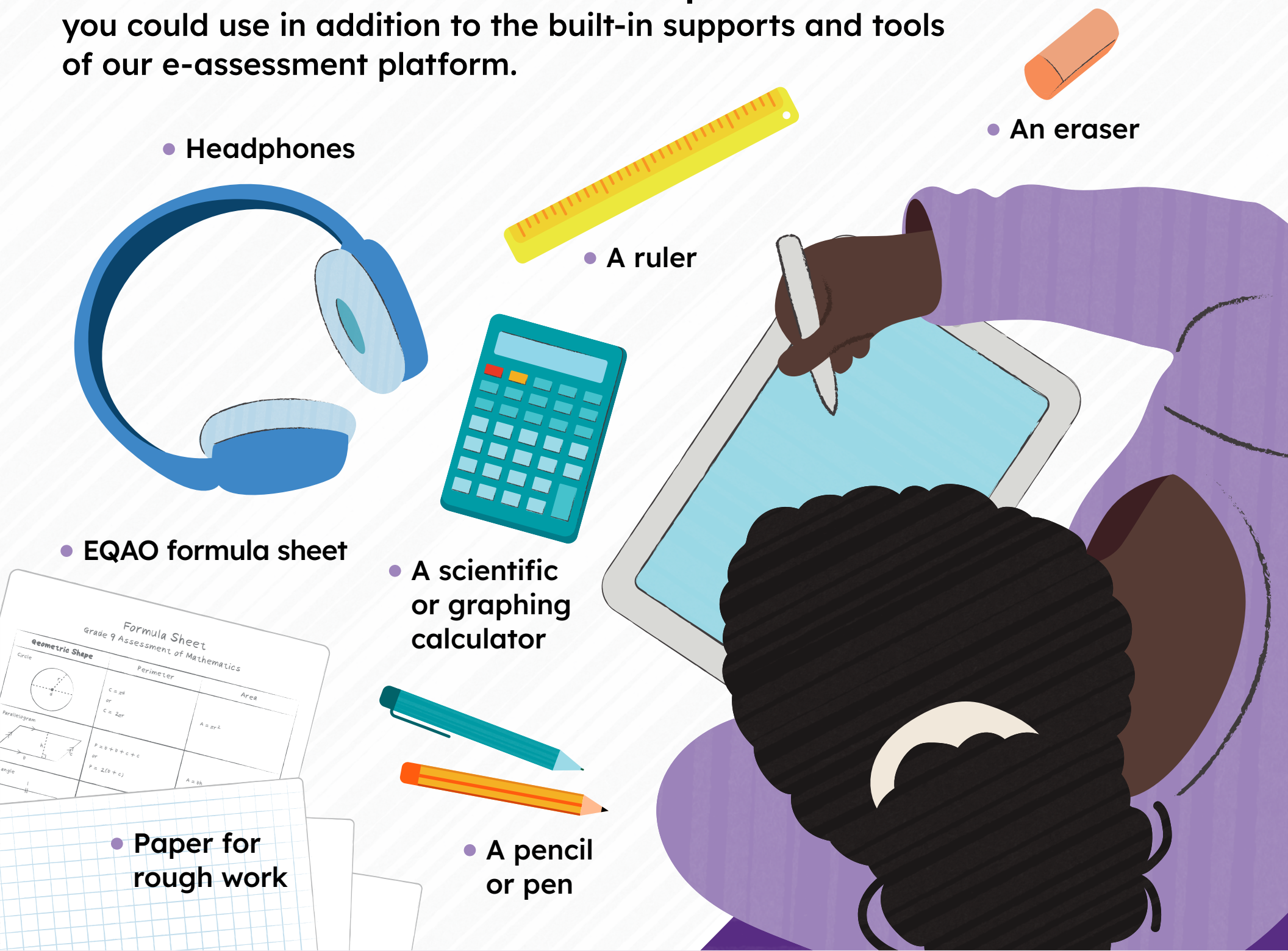


Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics
